

Sorting instructions – What goes where?

Green compost bin only for compostable waste

e.g. food leftovers, tea leaves, coffee filters, cold deep fryer fat, bones, nutshells, fruits, vegetables, small animal bedding, paper tissues, kitchen paper

To be collected
in waste bags made of paper!

Grey rubbish bin only for non recyclable waste

e.g. disposable nappies, sweepings, foam plastic, porcelain and stoneware, personal hygiene articles, sanitary towels, ballpens, pencil shavings, crayons, ashes, mirrors, window glass, treated wood, wall paper, photos, rubber products, carbon paper, rags, cleaning cloths

Yellow recycling bag for all packaging (except glass and paper)

made of plastic

e.g. yoghurt, margarine and curd cheese tubs, empty detergent bottles, styrofoam, foils, disposable cutlery and crockery

made of metal

e.g. cans, lids, aluminium foil

made of compounds

e.g. milk cartons, juice containers, packaging for coffee, cocoa, soup and frozen food

Paper

e.g. newspapers, uncoated carton packaging, catalogues, books, envelopes, magazines

Hazardous waste

e.g. adhesives, pesticides, brake fluid, fluorescent tubes, spray cans containing hazardous residues, drugs, varnishes/paints

Glass, empty disposable bottles and glasses

e.g. jam jars, empty cream jars, empty drug bottles, empty glass bottles for deodorants and perfumes
